Mossad and the Hidden War

It was also revealed that Mossad had recruited Afghani, Pakistani, and Iraqi individuals who directly or indirectly aided in smuggling weapons and equipment from Iraq into Iran and in transferring sensitive information and local agents for Mossad.

Estimates suggest that Mossad didn't simply plant traditional spies—it constructed sophisticated sleeper cells across Iran's military, security, political, administrative, commercial, and academic sectors, even among foreign residents, without arousing suspicion. When the attack began, nearly 99% of these elements were activated.

Notable signs of this activity include:

- · Assassination of first-tier military leaders following precise surveillance.
- · Elimination of prominent nuclear scientists.
- Stunning penetration of Iran's nuclear program.
- Infiltration into missile and drone development programs.
- · Access to decision-making hubs and administrative centers.
- Creation of internal workshops for drones and explosives.
- Purchase of real estate assets for covert operations.
- Smuggling of precision weapons used in special operations.
- · Execution of car bomb attacks.
- Construction of a comprehensive network for collecting, analyzing, and leaking information.
- Establishment of currency exchange kiosks for money transfers.

Is It Time for the "Great Purge"?

Tehran now faces an extraordinary moment—one that could evolve into a massive intelligence awakening. For the first time in years, the outlines of the breach are visibly clear, creating an opportunity to launch a full-scale "purge" akin to what European intelligence agencies carried out in the 1940s, but using modern tools.

The response must go beyond arrest campaigns and include:

- Detailed intelligence screening of the pre-strike period.
- Tracking the movements and communications of key figures.
- · Reviewing digital communication logs.
- Quietly and rigorously monitoring the sources of leaks and weaknesses.

Mossad Sacrificed Its Network for a Bigger Goal

It is evident that Israel chose to risk exposing its network within Iran. The activated elements were not the elite to be used in the next phase of operations but rather secondary local assets sacrificed for a larger strategic objective:

Destabilizing Iran's internal front and preparing the ground for a radical political shift.

This marks a transition from covert espionage to open attack—a calculated gamble by Israel indicating that the moment of exposure was imminent. Israel chose to strike first, execute the first phase successfully, and sacrifice expendable assets to protect core operatives.

Conclusion

The infiltration is now an undeniable reality, and dismantling the system from within has become a continuous objective. In contrast, Iran's response must rise to the level of the challenge—not through random or vengeful acts against dissidents, but through:

- · Professional intelligence operations,
- Scientific methodology,
- · Institutional fortification, and
- Rebuilding public trust in the state.

This is a unique opportunity that may not come again. What we are witnessing is not the end of a war, but the beginning of a shadow battle—within the state itself, where the enemy is unseen but its impact is devastating.
